

Dr. Bruce Burton International Student Involvement Award

The Dr. Bruce Burton International Student Involvement Award was established in 2011 to show how degree-seeking international students are becoming involved on campus. The award will not be defined by quantity of involvement but as much as quality, impact and consistency. This may include venturing into a group not previously attended by international students, by starting a new group or organization, or by developing a role in the group by taking on progressively greater responsibility.

Annually, nominees for this award can be made by faculty, staff, or by the student him/herself. One recipient from each college will be recognized for their involvement. There will be one student selected from the four finalists, who most exemplifies and embodies the spirit of campus involvement, to receive the \$500 cash award.
