## BA 4 year plan notes

Notes for BA Music 4 year plans by semester 17-18

### General notes for all BA Students

1. Many BA students are double majors or pursue at least one additional minor. This plan allows for flexibility but does not guarantee graduation in 4 years
2. It is solely the responsibility of the student to see all advisors to get a 4-year suggested semester-by-semester course plan for each major in which they enroll, and/or any requirements for minor(s) in which they enroll
3. 21 hrs. of electives outside of Music required for all Music BA's (not MUSC, MUSE or MUSL)
4. A project is required for **each concentration for which the student is enrolled**
5. The three MUSC Electives American Music, African Music, and Jazz History and Literature are offered only in spring on a 3-year rotating basis—see the most current department course rotation for more details
6. Music History courses do not have to be in sequence. The second semester can be Advanced Conducting.
7. Distributional/general education courses can generally be taken during any semester, but the 2 semesters of Modern Language must be sequential and ideally should be completed before your high school language classes are forgotten

#### Notes for Music BA's by Semester:

##### Fall Semester 18-19:

1. Register for MUSL 2381 or 2391, Second Year Proficiency, when you register for spring courses (2381 is for Music History/Lit. and Theory/Comp. majors; 2391 is for Applied Studies majors)
2. Check Degree Works for audit of your progress for graduation. **MAKE SURE THE PROJECTED GRADUATION DATE IS CORRECT.**

##### Spring Semester 18-19:

1. Register for MUSL 2041 after piano proficiency (0 credits) is passed, ideally in fall 19-20, if it is required for your concentration
2. Pass 2<sup>nd</sup> year applied proficiency exam (MUSL 2391—Applied Studies only) or MUSL 2381 (Music History and Lit., Theory/Comp.) at jury. MUSL 2391 is a prerequisite to make sure you are ready for 3<sup>rd</sup> year 3000 level lessons. If you don't pass MUSL 2391 by spring of the 2<sup>nd</sup> year, you will not be able to take applied

lessons in your area during your junior year first semester, which will result in being "off track"

3. *Check Degree Works for audit of your progress for graduation. MAKE SURE THE PROJECTED GRADUATION DATE IS CORRECT.*
