#### New Databases Available

The following tools are located under the "[Periodicals](#)" heading on the Heterick home page.

#### Classical Music Library

This new service features a large and continually growing collection of classical music recordings for listening, browsing and searching, benchmarked against the Music Library Association listing of essential sound recordings. It includes the following features.

- **Fully licensed and legal music service**

Classical has licensed recordings from some of the most respected classical music labels in the US, UK and Europe, and legally compensates artists and labels.

- **Extensive reference resource**

1000's of program notes, composer biographies, and images cross-referenced to the recordings.

- **Advanced search functionality**

Ability to research our music and reference material in a range of ways suited to level of knowledge.

- **Recommended playlists**

100's of recommended classical music playlists presented by themes and categories.

- **User-friendly interface**

Enables patrons to organize, create, save and share their own selections of music.

- **Optional Download and Custom CD functionality**

Facility for users to purchase and own any of our recordings in digital or CD format, if you choose to include this functionality.

### **American Periodical Series Online, 1740 – 1900**

This database currently provides searchable coverage to more than 1,000 periodicals. 89 journals were published between 1740, more than 200 titles from the first 60 years of the nineteenth century, 118 periodicals from the Civil War (1861-1865) and Reconstruction (1865-1877) eras and numerous titles from the 1880s through 1900.

Articles are reproduced in PDF format so users can see all of the original typography, drawings, graphic elements, and article layouts exactly as they were originally published. Additional information is provided on the historical significance of all the periodicals represented in the database.

### ***CCH Research Network***

This database provides access to dozens of CCH products covering such topics as: health law including Medicare and Medicaid, healthcare compliance, state Medicaid laws & regulations, state health care laws & regulations, and managed care; food & drug law; human resources management including personnel practices, compensation, equal employment opportunity, employment relations, and OSHA compliance; payroll management including social security and unemployment; pensions & benefits law; employment law including employment practices, disabilities management, labor relations, wages & hours, labor arbitration, EEOC compliance, and state employment law; and safety, OSHA, and workers compensation law.

### **E-Journals Added**

The following publications from the Institute of Physics have been added to the [Electronic Journals Collection](#) (EJC).

Journal of Geophysics and Engineering (<http://www.iop.org/journals/jge>) Published by the Nanjing Institute of Geophysical Prospecting and the Institute of Physics, this major new publication promotes research and developments in geophysics and related areas of engineering. It has predominantly an applied science and engineering focus, but also publishes contributions in all earth-physics disciplines from global geophysics to applied and engineering geophysics.

Journal of Neural Engineering Journal of Neural Engineering (<http://www.iop.org/journals/jne>) is a new forum for the interdisciplinary field of neural engineering, where neuroscientists, neurobiologists and engineers can publish their work in one periodical that bridges the gap between neuroscience and engineering. Articles will cover the field of neural engineering at the molecular, cellular and systems levels.

Journal of Statistical Mechanics: Theory and Experiment (<http://www.iop.org/journals/jstat>) Journal of Statistical Mechanics: Theory and Experiment is an authoritative, peer-reviewed international journal created by the International School for Advanced Studies and the Institute of Physics. It brings together cutting-edge research in all aspects of statistical physics, particularly emphasizing experimental work that impacts on fundamental aspects of the subject.

Physical Biology (<http://www.iop.org/journals/physbio>) Physical Biology fosters the integration of biology with the traditionally more quantitative fields of physics, chemistry, computer science and other math-based disciplines. Its primary aim is to further the understanding of biological systems at all levels of complexity, ranging from the role of structure and dynamics of a single molecule to cellular networks and organisms (i.e. systems biology).

Journal of Cosmology and Astroparticle Physics: Created by the International School for Advanced Studies and the Institute of Physics, the journal is receiving industry acclaim and is exceeding all editorial expectations - to date, over 1,000 pages of research have been published and more than 100 articles have been accepted. ### **Industry Profiles Added to Business Source Premier**

Approximately 1,800 quality full text industry profiles (reports) from three different content providers are now available in the [Business Source Premier](#) (BSP) database. This number is expected to grow by some 1000 profiles within the next two months, 1,000 additional industry profiles from DataMonitor will be available in BSP. The publisher anticipates that full text industry profiles will be added regularly, as this information becomes available. To access this information, simply click on the "Company Profiles" button in the green bar across the BSP main screen.
