

## Dress Code during the 2019 Summer Academic and Honors Institute

Students must have their SAHI student badge/ID visible.

Keep in mind that you will spend most of your time in air-conditioned buildings, unless you are out in the field collecting specimens. Closed-toe shoes must be worn at all times in the buildings. Discretion should be used as to the appropriateness and safety of certain types of shoes. You may be required to wear safety devices or uniforms that ensure your safety and/or unrestricted movement.

In addition, you must *not* wear:

- Clothing bearing racially or sexually offensive messages
- Any apparel that denotes membership in a gang or advocates drug use or violence
- Clothing that exposes your shoulders or undergarments
- Jeans with holes or tears
- Slippers or cleats inside buildings
- Attire that could damage school property or cause personal injury to others (such as chains)
- Clothing that is suggestive, has a double meaning or innuendo, or suggests inappropriate ideas
