

# UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER SESSIONS

The semester undergraduate summer sessions are set to two, five-week terms. Each academic term has 24 weekdays (5 weeks each, but one day is a holiday). The Academic Affairs Committee has approved the following time slots for scheduling three-credit-hour lecture courses. Laboratories can utilize combined time slots as need be.

## **MTWRF:**

Slot #1: 8:00 - 9:40 a.m.

Slot #2: 10:00 - 11:40 a.m.

Slot #3: 1:00 - 2:40 p.m.

Slot #4: 3:00 - 4:40 p.m.

**Days 1 through 22** will be instructional days, with the three-credit-hour course meeting for 100 minutes each day.

**Days 23 and 24** of the five-week term will be reserved for final examinations. Thus, the summer term three-credit-hour lecture courses will meet for a total of 2200 minutes in the summer term. This is comparative to the fall and spring course offerings which meet for no more than 45 sessions of 50 minutes each, or 2200 minutes. The proposed final examination schedule is:

- **Day 23:** the 8:00 a.m. course section final examination would be held from 8:00 - 10:00 a.m. and the 10:00 a.m. final would be held from 10:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
- **Day 24:** The 1:00 p.m. course section final examination would be held from 1:00-3:00 p.m. and the 3:00 p.m. class would be 3:30 - 5:30 p.m.

The intent of the final examination schedule is to test the students in a similar time block as to when they meet for class in order to accommodate work schedules.
