Choose Ohio First Scholarships are multi-year renewable scholarships (pending funding from the State of Ohio). The scholarships are awarded to promising undergraduates who are interested in pursuing a major in the Center for Teacher Education with a major in biology, chemistry, physics, mathematics, technology education, engineering education or middle childhood education with mathematics or science concentrations. Other requirements:

- Applicants must be residents of the State of Ohio or a graduate of an Ohio high school.
- Potential recipients must have an overall cumulative high school grade point average of 3.3 or above (or the equivalent) and an ACT composite score of 24 or higher (or equivalent percentile SAT score). Transfer students must have a GPA of 3.0 or above from their previous college.
