



# Ministerial Deduction Application

Under the Ministerial Deduction Policy of Ohio Northern University, unmarried legally dependent children under age 25 of United Methodist Ordained Elders in full connection, good standing, and under full-time appointment by the Annual Conference may receive, upon request, a deduction for tuition and general fees. The award is coordinated with all other university financial aid. Academic scholarships may be adjusted.

The policy also applies to children of retired or deceased United Methodist ministers with the same credentials. The policy applies only for students in their first four years who are seeking their first baccalaureate degree, excluding summer sessions.
