Apply for Admission

- Apply by December 1 of senior year of high school for maximum scholarship consideration

Academic Scholarships

- Scholarships sent immediately after acceptance package
- Renewed automatically throughout bachelor degree program (first 4 years for Pharmacy students)
- We do superscore ACT and SAT for scholarship purposes
 - December ACT of senior year is last score considered
- We will use the weighted HS GPA if reported on HS transcript
- Scholarships available for those applying test optional
- Financial aid calculator on ONU website onu.edu/scholarship-and-cost-calculator

(College of Pharmacy - \$25,000)

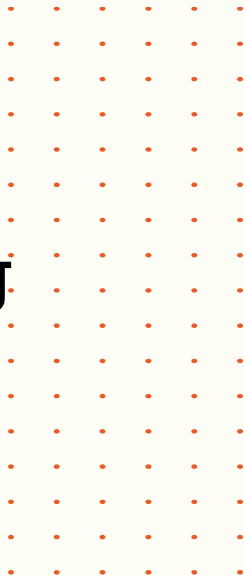
Trustee Scholarship

File the FAFSA


- Free Application for Federal Student Aid
- Form that collects demographic and financial information about the student and family
- Complete FAFSA online at www.FAFSA.gov
- Available after October 1
- Uses prior year tax information (2021)
- List up ONU to receive your information – ONU school code is **003089**





FAFSA and EFC

- Information provided on the FAFSA is used to calculate the EFC
 - Amount that a family can reasonably be expected to contribute as determined by the Federal Government
 - EFC is the same at all institutions
 - Two components
 - Parent contribution
 - Student contribution
- We use the EFC to award financial aid at ONU

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Special Circumstances

- Cannot report special circumstances on the FAFSA
- Contact the ONU Financial Aid Office for assistance
- Examples:
 - Change in employment status
 - Medical expenses not covered by insurance
 - Change in parent marital status
 - Unusual dependent care expenses
 - Student cannot obtain parental information

ONU Award Package

- Will be mailed starting in December if student is accepted and FAFSA received
- Includes all scholarships, grants, loans and work opportunities
 - Federal Government
 - State Government
 - Ohio Northern
 - \$57 million budget for scholarships and grants
 - Average student scholarship and grant offer is \$25,000
 - External Scholarships
